Mentimeter

We will be using “Mentimeter” during some of the presentations at the event, you will be able to use your smartphone or device to connect to the presentation where you can answer questions, give feedback and much more. You will be supplied with joining details at the event and information on how to use the tool.

Project Lift

The Project Lift team will be delivering a session after lunch, they will be focusing on you as a leader. It would be fabulous if you would make some time to fill in the Project Lift Leadership Profile Self-Assessment for yourself before joining us at the learning event on the 9 September, and if you bring your personalised report along with you, it will be a useful guide for you and make you really think and appreciate the importance of seeing yourself as a leader!

Instructions: On the home page click on ‘Get Started’ at the top right hand of the screen. You will then be asked to log in via your Turas account or asked to create a Turas account using the instructions provided on the website. You will then set up your profile by answering some questions prior to completing the Self Assessment Questionnaire. Whilst you might not see the scenarios mirrored in your current role, try to think of what decisions you would make as a leader.

Further information on Project Lift: The NHS in Scotland recognises that the collective contribution of everyone as a leader can and does make a real difference to transforming care. We encourage everyone to start with themselves first. At project lift we have developed a leadership profile and a self-assessment questionnaire to support you to develop your own leadership approach and skills. This self-assessment takes around 20 minutes to complete and will give you a personalised report which will help you reflect and consider where your own strengths lie and encourage you to think about your development as a leader.

1. Fire Procedure
