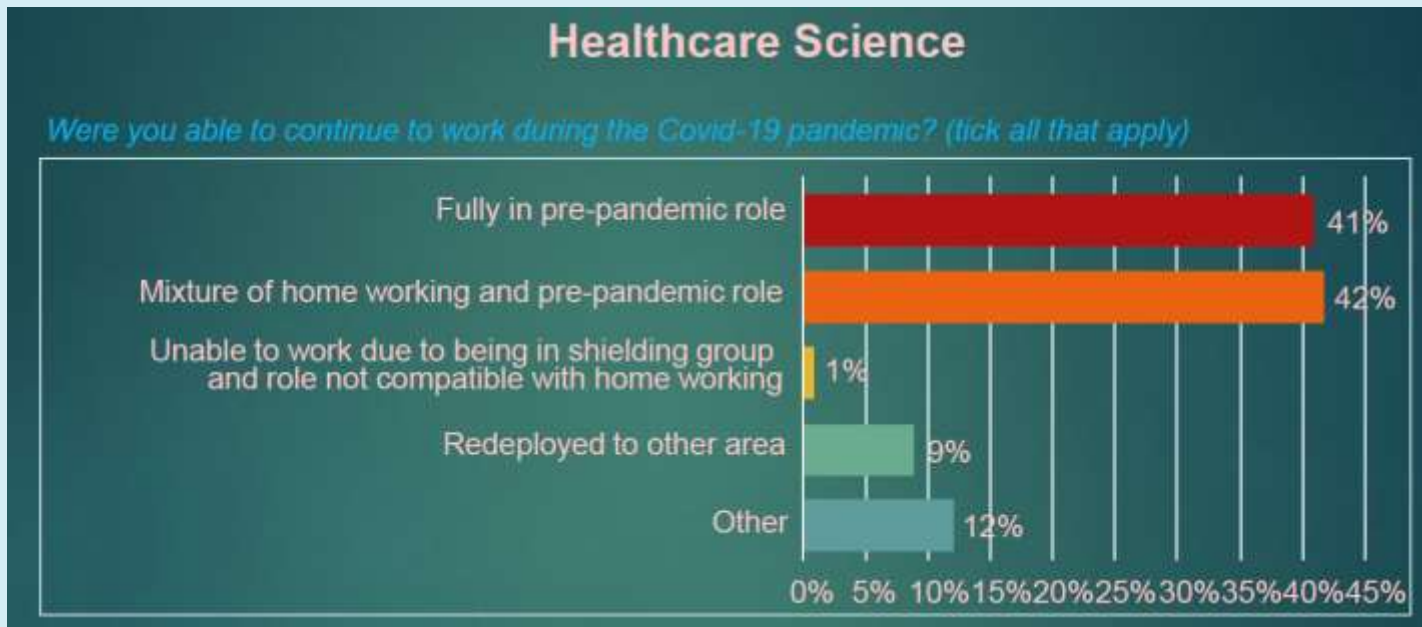
# HCS Surveys in 2020

# NES Covid Impact Survey 2020

71% response rate from 176 trainees (N=125)

## 51% of HCS trainees did some home working or were redeployed



# NES Covid Impact Survey 2020

71% response rate from 176 trainees (N=125)



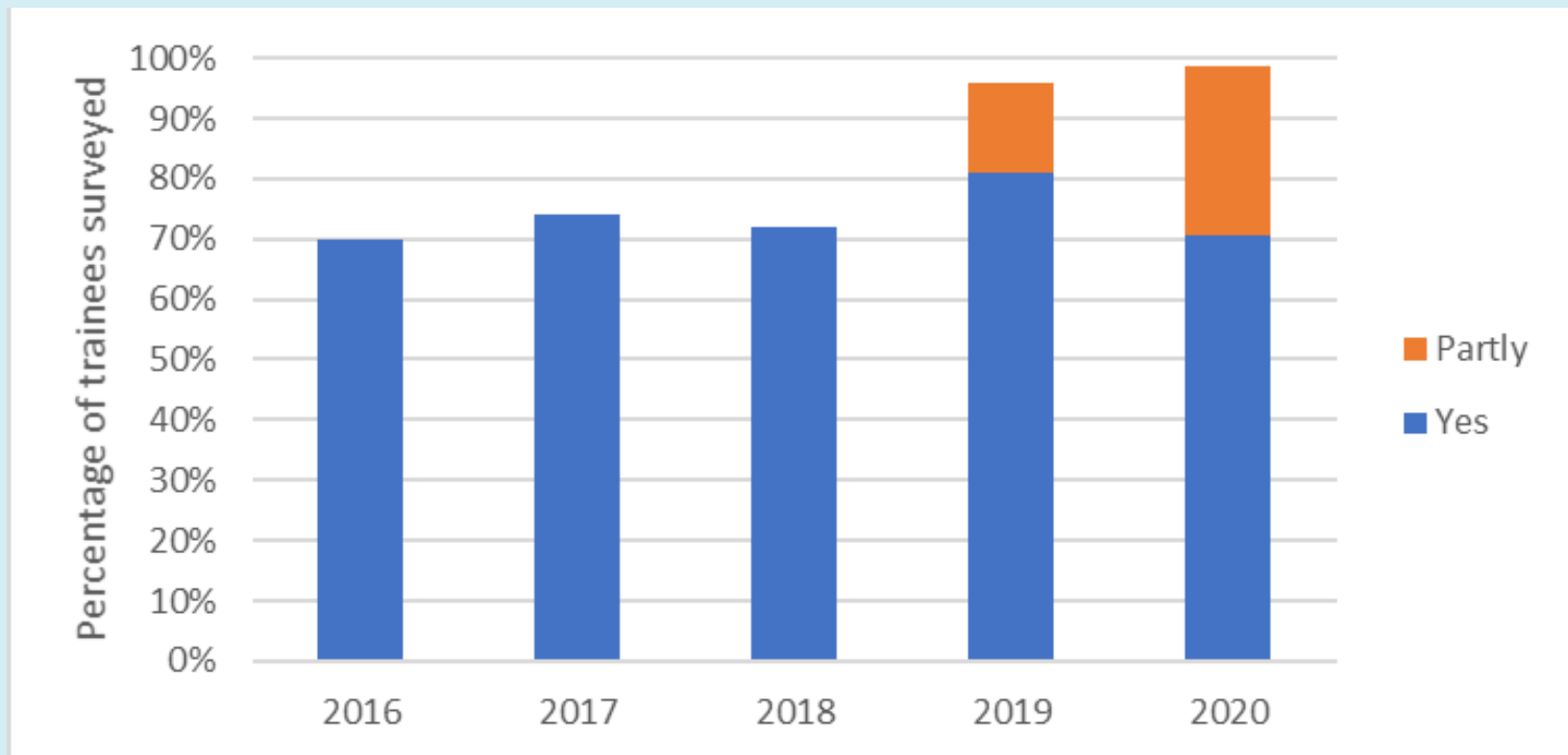
## Trainees also indicated Covid-19 impacted their ability to:

- **Attend face-to-face courses: 61%**
- **Undertake practical training elements: 46%**
- **Undertake rotational training visits: 44%**

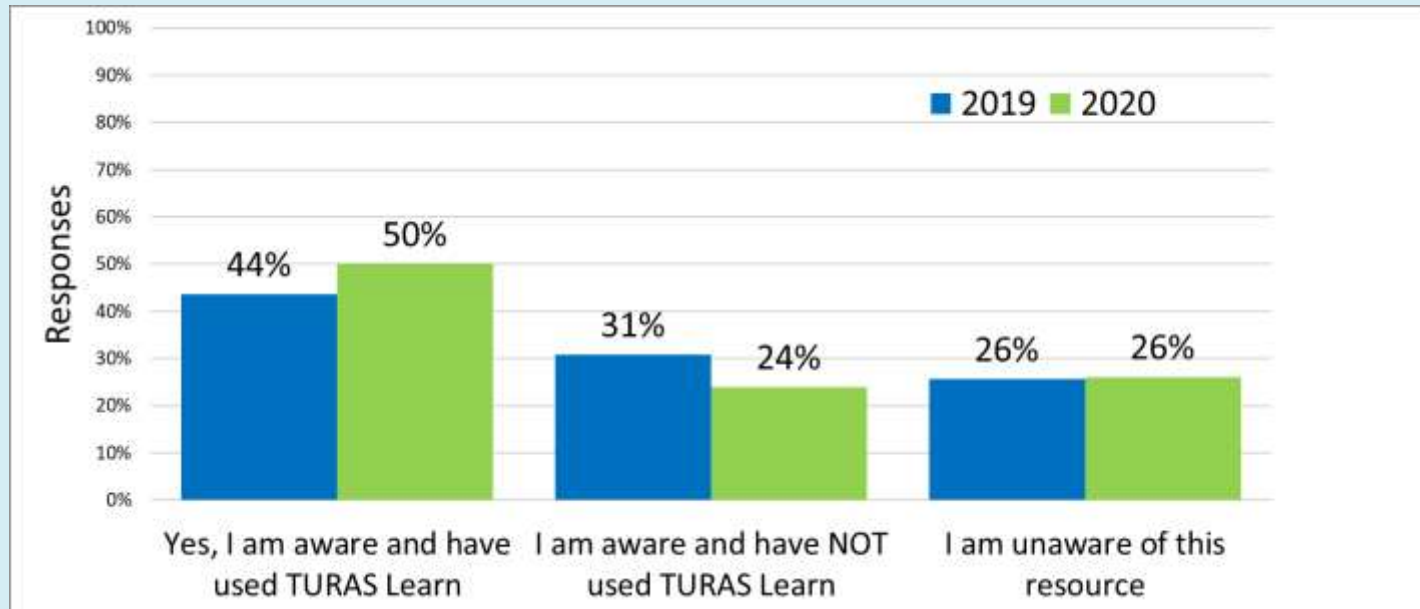
## Have you undergone an Annual Review of Competency Progression or formal review?

43% of 108 supervisors (N=46) in 2020

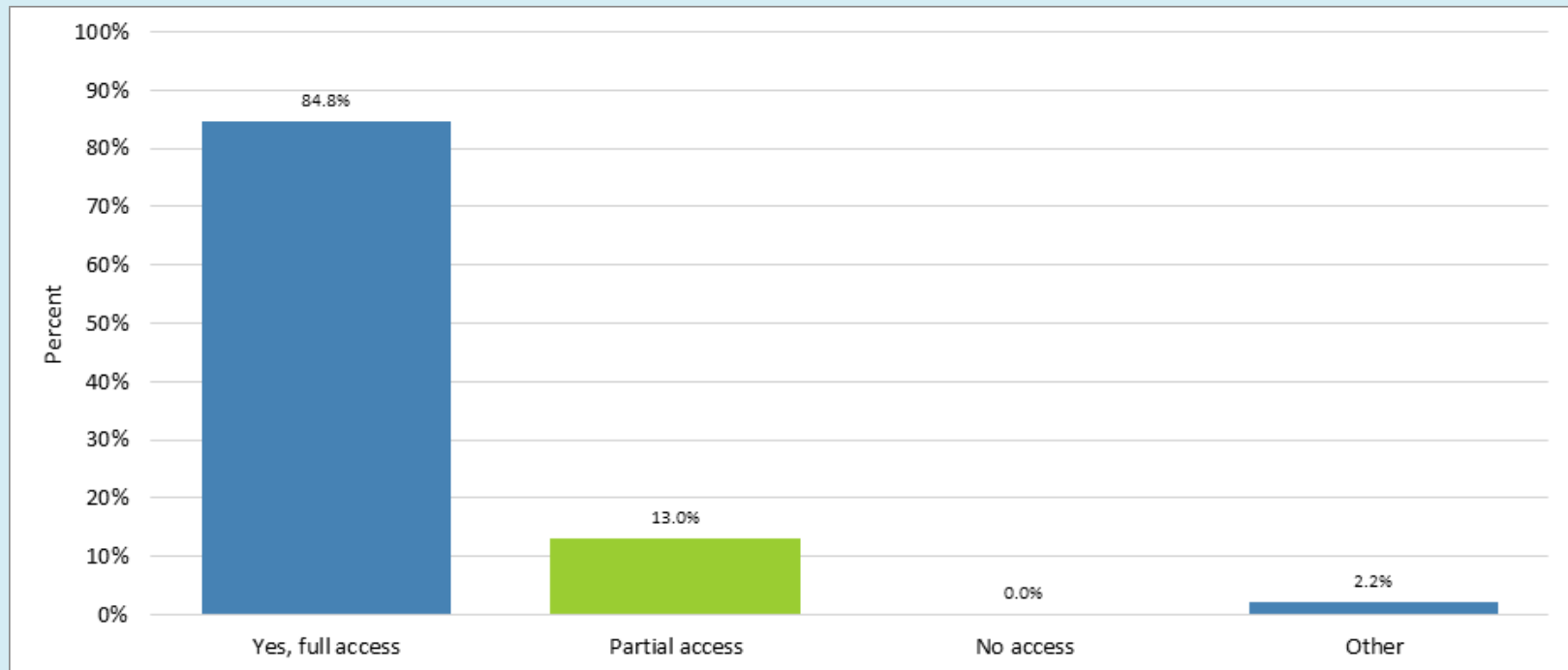
## Are you aware of TURAS Learn and the new Healthcare Science e-learning zone?

## Do you have access to the equipment and space to engage with e-learning in your work environment?

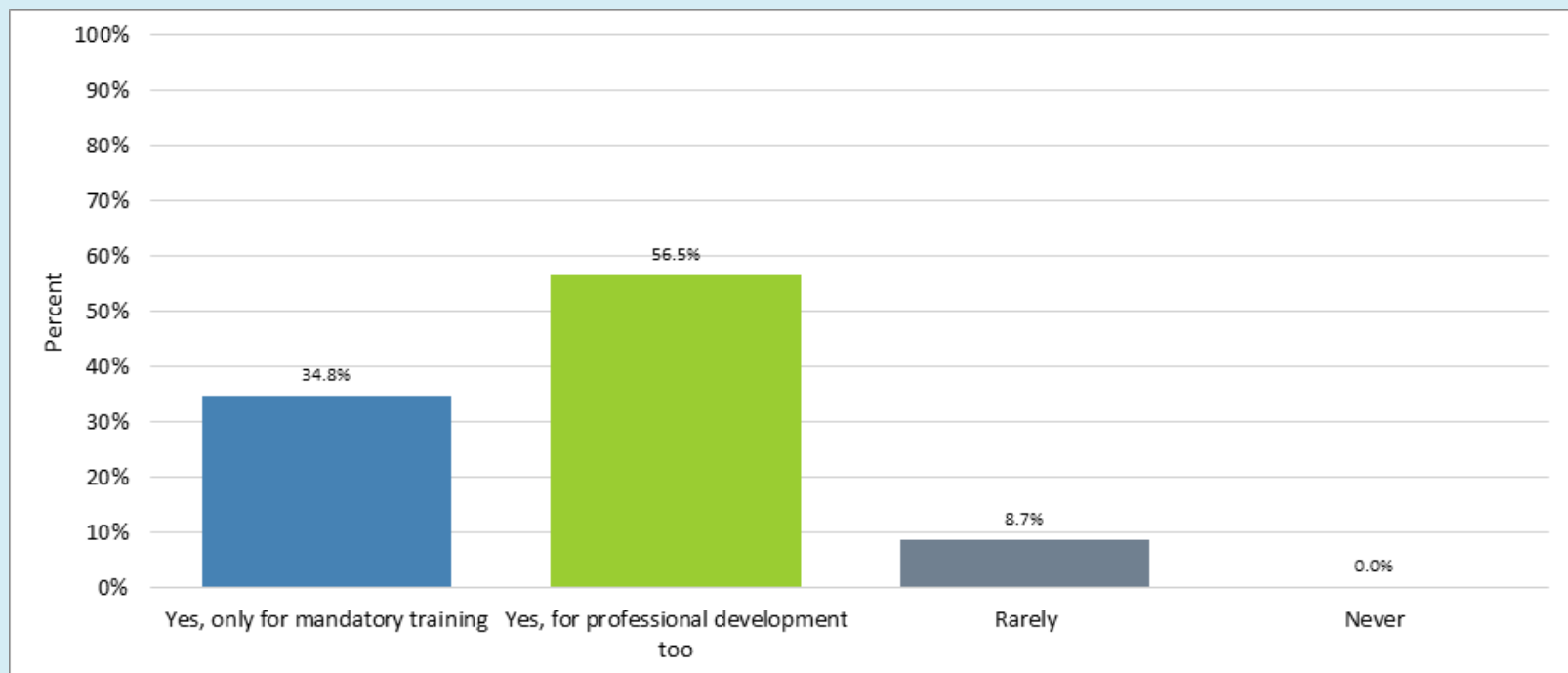

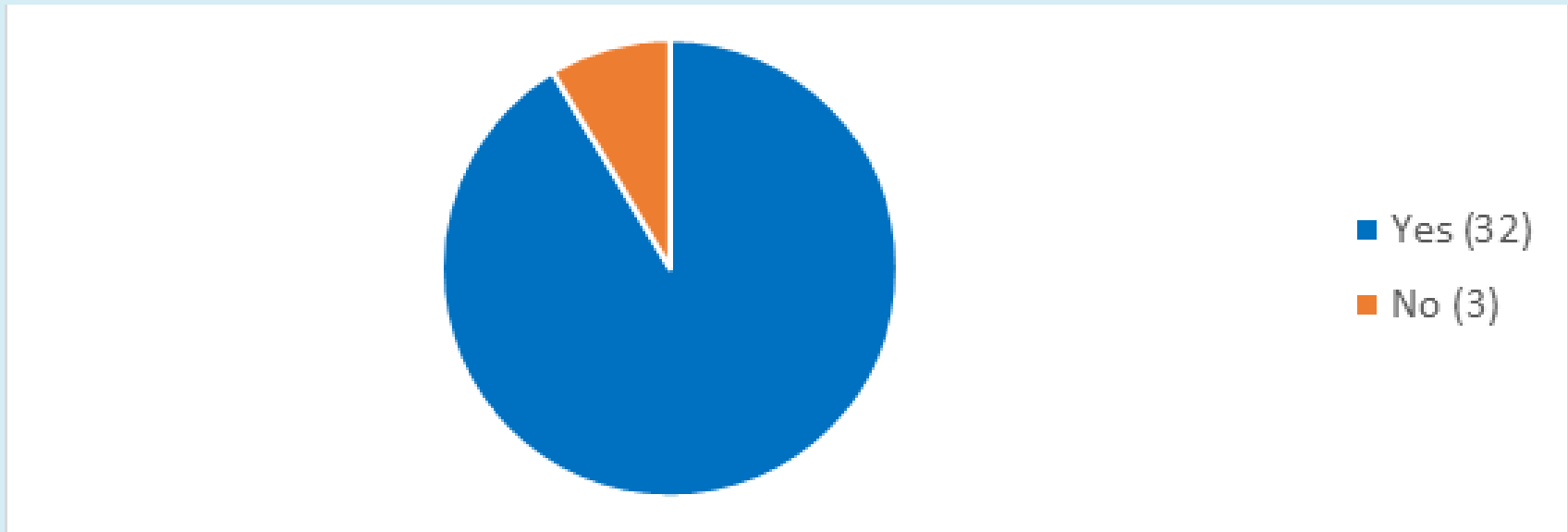
## Have you used e-learning resources in the last year?
