
Derek Feeley chaired

The National care service will oversee the delivery of care, improve standards, ensure enhanced pay and conditions for workers and provide better support for unpaid carers.




Consultation on the proposals for a National Care Service

- Scottish Ministers assume statutory responsibility for social care across Scotland;
- an NCS that will oversee the delivery of care, improve standards, ensure enhanced pay and conditions for workers and provide better support for unpaid carers;
- new local community health and social care boards that would deliver services, reporting to the NCS; and
- that the scope of the NCS includes adult social work and social care services, community health provision, Children's social work and social care and Justice Social Work, therefore supporting an integrated and collaborative approach to support and care for people of all ages.

Just under 1300 responses were received.

There was broad agreement with the Government's proposals to bring together social care and community health services for all ages under the National Care Service.

Risks were also described in the feedback.
