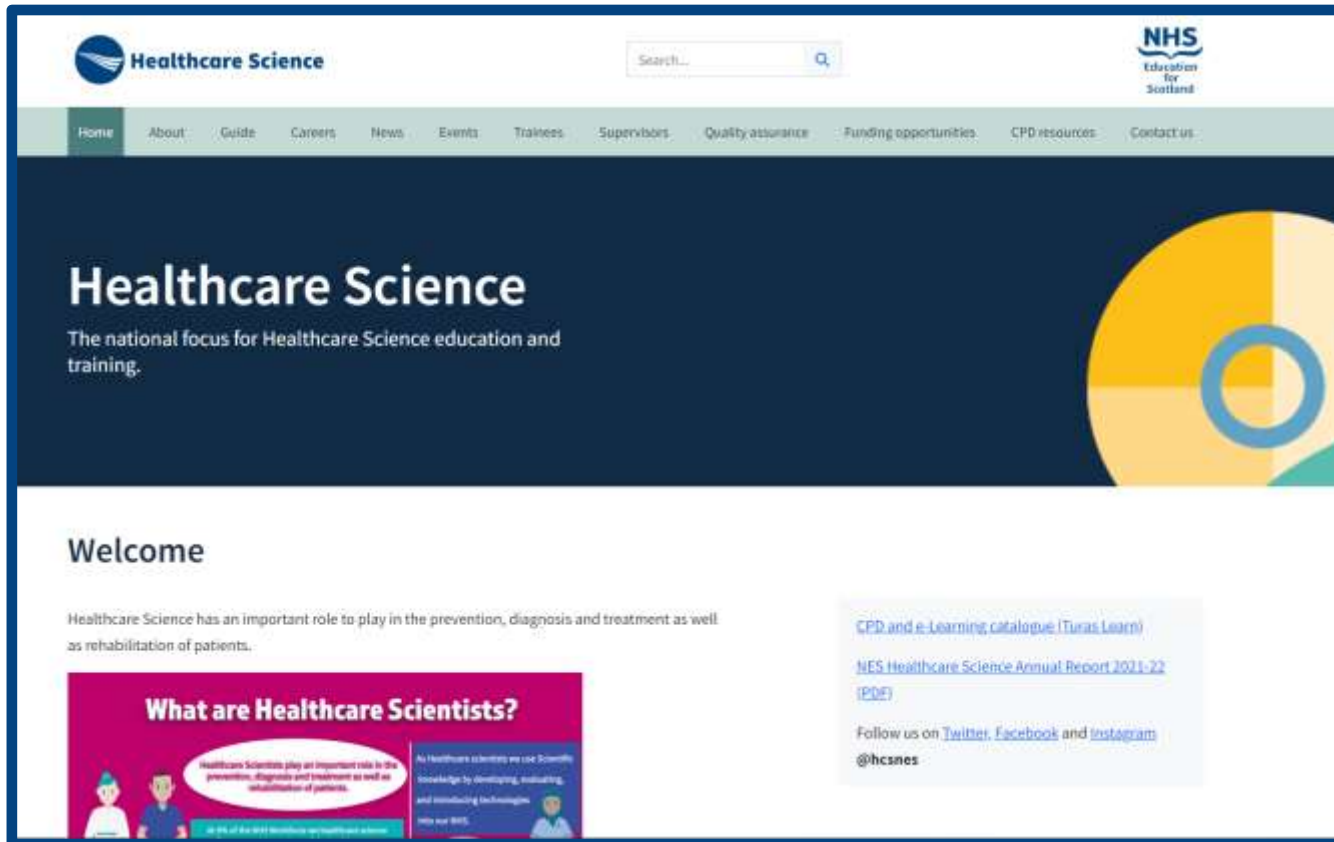

- take a minimum of 10 hours to complete
